If you cannot receive the Sacrament of the Sick before entering the Hospital, ask the Chaplain's office to contact a Catholic Priest who can administer the Sacrament for you. 
PRAYER BLANKET/SHAWL MINISTRY



Matthew Kelly has a new book out, "33 Days to Eucharistic Glory" (Dynamic Catholic, 2023). You guessed correctly: It is set up to be read over 33 days — or a bit longer if that's what you need. The book builds from where we are to where we are going and then to making a commitment, a solid commitment, to living for our LORD. In addition to this small paperback, there are daily videos from Fr. Jonathan Meyer and Matthew Kelly and his children. One of the daily videos ends with a prayer. It's a spin on the prayer that we became all too familiar with during Covid.:

Jesus, I believe that you are truly present in the most holy sacrament of the Eucharist. Every day I long for more of you. I love you above all things and I desire to receive you into my soul. Since I cannot receive you sacramentally at this moment, I invite you to come into my heart. May this spiritual communion increase my desire for the Eucharist. You are the healer of my soul; take the blindness from my eyes, the deafness from my ears, the darkness from my mind and the hardness from my heart. Fill me with the grace, wisdom and courage to do your will in all things. My Lord and my God draw me close to you, nearer than ever before. Amen.

I find this to be a powerful little book and resource. Of course, we'll get out of it what we put into it.
