How Can I Get to the Parish During Road

Construction on Janes Avenue began Wednesday, April 24 and will continue through the end of the summer. During Phase I, only northbound traffic will be allowed on Janes Avenue from 83rd Street to the driveway closest to Dunkin Donuts south of 75th Street. Southbound traffic will be diverted to Woodward Avenue, where you will be allowed to come north on Janes Avenue (traffic may be slow due to construction) to the front entrance to the parish parking lot. Another way to access our parking lot from the north is to take Woodridge Drive south (this is the stop light between Janes Avenue and 53rd) to Jonquil, where you will turn left. Jonquil ends at Chestnut, where you will follow the road, curving right. You can then access the parking lot to the left.

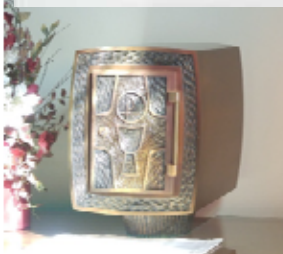

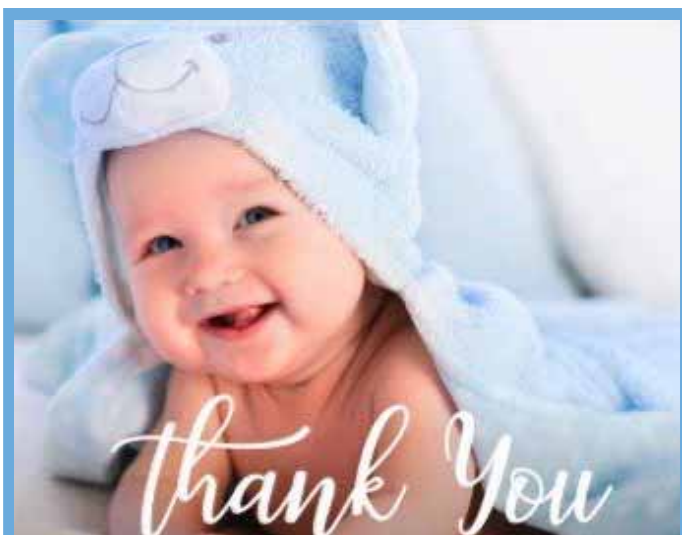
provide the students with appropriate support and supervision as our numbers continue to grow.

NATIONAL Eucharistic Revival

About the National Eucharistic Revival –

The [National Eucharistic Revival](#) is a three-year initiative intended to spark a movement of renewal within the Catholic Church by enkindling a living relationship with Jesus Christ in the Eucharist.

Faced with the knowledge that only one-third of self-described Catholics believe in the Real Presence, the [U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops \(USCCB\)](#) approved, in 2021, both the revival and a teaching document on the Eucharist.

Bishop Hicks and the Diocese of Joliet joined the rest of the nation in kicking off the National Eucharistic Revival with the **year of diocesan revival**, on the Feast of Corpus Christi 2022 with Mass and a Eucharistic procession.

The **year of parish revival** began on the Feast of Corpus Christi 2023 and continues with events such as a regular Holy Hour. (each 1st Monday at St. Scholastica)

The revival will culminate in a [National Eucharistic Congress](#) held from July 17 to 24, 2024, in Indianapolis; the event is expected to draw 80,000 Catholics.

The final year of the revival, marked from July 21, 2024, to Pentecost 2025, will send us all out into the world to share the gift of the Eucharist!

National Eucharistic Pilgrimage

The National Eucharistic Pilgrimage kicked off during the weekend of Pentecost 2024. Four groups are walking with Jesus across the country for approximately two months. All will meet in Indianapolis on July 16 to attend the National Eucharistic Congress from July 17–July 21, 2024.

The pilgrimage will pass through Chicagoland in late June, beginning June 26, 2024, with a Mass, Adoration and a Procession at Mundelein Seminary and ending with two events in Whiting, Indiana, on July 1.

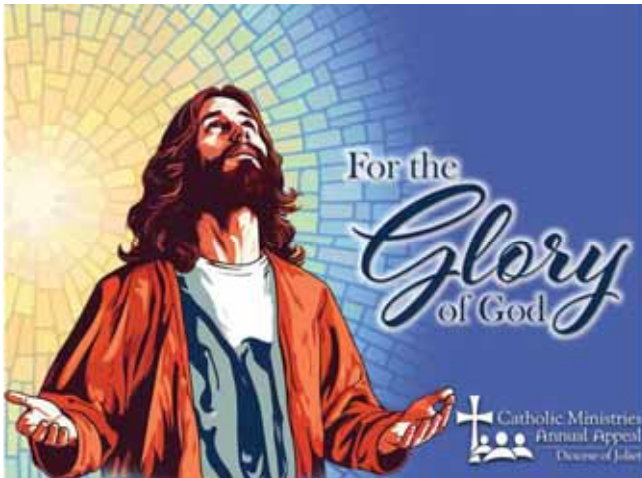

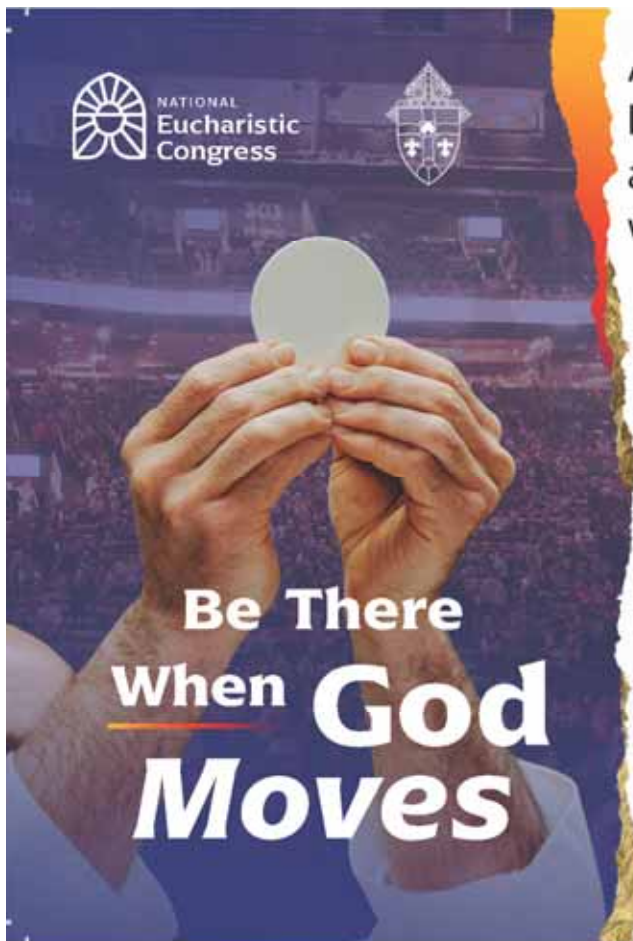
